In order to encourage closer cooperative ties, the Institute for Migration and Ethnic Studies Zagreb, Croatia and the Institute of Slavic Studies of the Russian Academy of Sciences, Moscow, Russia, wish to enter into an agreement of cooperation and collaboration in areas of mutual interest and benefit to both institutions. This agreement will serve as a general framework for cooperation and is intended to facilitate further discussions of specific programs of collaboration.

The aim is to stimulate the comparative study of migration, minorities and ethnicity, to promote public understanding of the complex realities of these topics, and also, through research and discussion, to stimulate the implementation of new policies and activities that might help in the solution of problems in the relevant fields.

In particular, the two institutions agree to:

- identify opportunities for research collaboration;
- conduct, where possible, joint research on topics of mutual interest;
- publish and exchange the research results;
- organise scientific and professional discussions (symposia, conferences, forums, round tables) in the fields of migration, minority and ethnic studies;
- enable interested researchers and students to use the library funds and provide them opportunities for independent research and/or participation in research within the scope of scientific research activities of the institutions;
- cooperate in other areas of mutual interest.
